However, interested Institutions may obtain AICTE approval. Those who want to withdraw their application under Chapter 1 or 2 for A. Y. 2020-21 may do so on or before 16th March 2020 and they will be reimbursed entire TER charges. Those who wish to take approval of AICTE may confirm the same to continue with the application. Those who do not inform will be considered as interested in continuing approval of AICTE, and their applications shall be processed as per APH 2020-21. Confirmation is requested by uploading a letter (only in PDF) signed by an Authorized Signatory on AICTE portal **on or before 16th March 2020**
