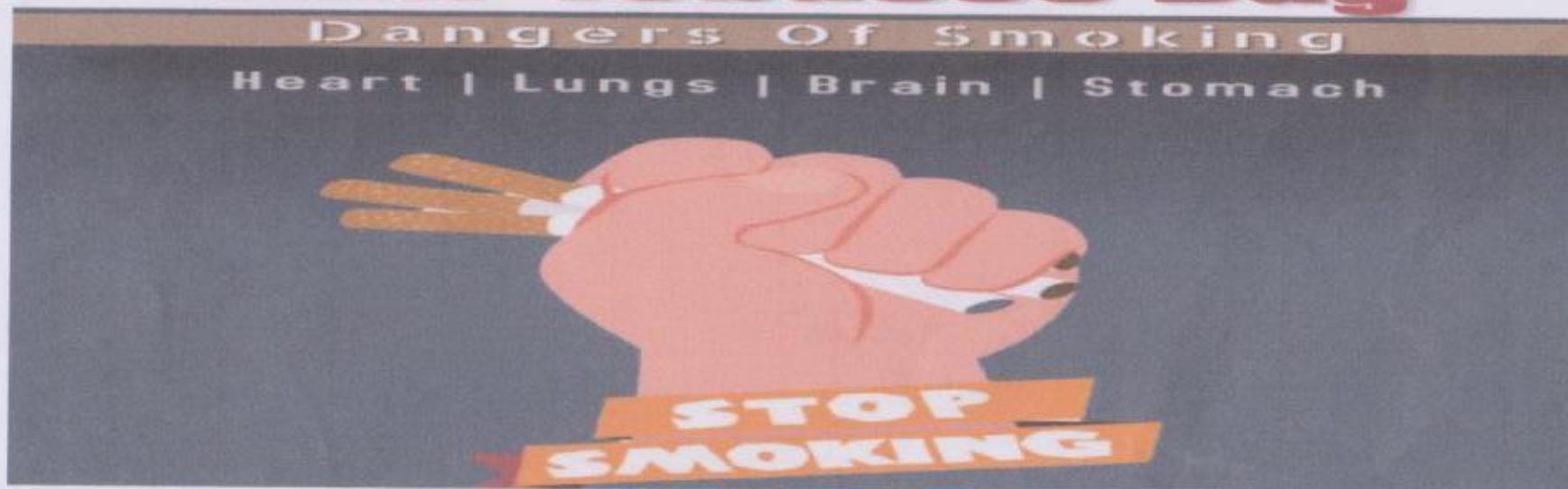

World Anti Tobacco Day (ATD) is organized every year on May 31 to highlight the health and other risks associated with tobacco use, and advocating for effective policies to reduce tobacco consumption globally. ATD was created by WHO in 1987 to draw global attention to the tobacco epidemic and the preventable death and disease it causes.

On this day, WHO Calls on millions of tobacco users to take the pledge and quit tobacco today.

Anti Tobacco Day (ATD)-Theme 'Commit to Quit'

This yearly celebration informs the public on the dangers of using tobacco, the business practices of tobacco companies, what WHO is doing to fight the tobacco epidemic, and what people around the world can do to claim their right to health and healthy living and to protect future generations.

The Member States of the World Health Organization created World No Tobacco Day in 1987 to draw global attention to the tobacco epidemic and the preventable death and disease it causes. In 1987, the World Health Assembly passed Resolution WHA40.38, calling for 7 April 1988 to be a "a world no-smoking day." In 1988, Resolution WHA42.19 was passed, calling for the celebration of World No Tobacco Day, every year on 31 May.

The day was celebrated at Vikas Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences. All the teaching staff, non-teaching staff, students were participated in the occasion. The Chief Guest addressed the gathering on the importance of quitting the smoking.





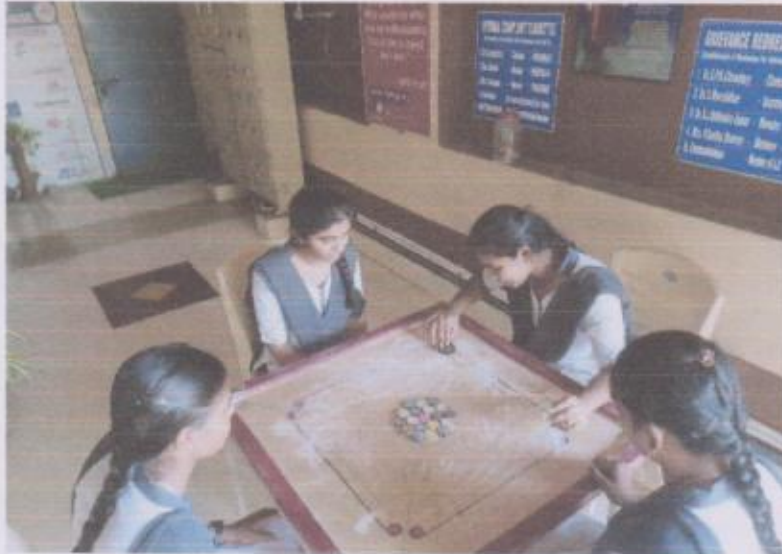

Abrus precatorius Linn.: A Pilot study in Suicidal Patients

Introduction

Abrus precatorius (Fabaceae) is commonly called as 'poisonous bean' or 'rosary pea'. *Abrus* contains a potent toxin, abrin, along with smaller concentrations of glycyrrhizic acid, and N-methyltryptophan. Abrin and ricin inhibit ribosomal protein synthesis, leading to cell death.

Beans or beans swallowed whole with the husk outer shell intact typically prevent absorption of significant toxin. Chewed or crushed seeds or beans may release the toxin and cause local toxicity in the GI tract, leading to gastroenteritis, abdominal pain, dehydration, and electrolyte disturbances. If abrin or ricin is absorbed systemically, these symptoms may progress to severe neurologic toxicity (seizures, coma), cerebral edema, disseminating encephalitis, multi-organ failure, and death.

Abrin is one of the most lethal known poisons, inducing severe vomiting, high fever, drowsing, highly elevated levels of serum ammonia, liver failure, bladder failure, bleeding from the eyes, and convulsive seizures.

Methods

This was a study conducted with the case records of patients (age >13 years) admitted to medicine wards over a period of 7 years (January 2009-December 2015). Institute Scientific Committee and Ethics Committee approvals were obtained. A pro forma was used to collect data regarding the sex, age, duration of hospital stay, number of seeds consumed, route of ingestion, symptoms, complications and the outcome.

Results

We studied a total of 9 patients admitted due to *A. precatorius* poisoning. Most of the patients were females (78.7%). Most of the patients (83%) were between 13 and 20 years of age, with 44.4% between 11 and 20 years of age. The duration of hospital stay ranged from a single day to a maximum of 9 days, most of the with a stay duration of a single day (44.22%). The most common form of ingestion was crushed seeds (56-40%). Majority of the patient presented with gastrointestinal symptoms (72.22%) in the form of loose stools, vomiting, and pain abdomen. Bloody diarrhea was present in 29.2%. Neurological involvement in the form altered sensorium, tremors, and seizures were present in 9 patients. Severe patients (11.1%) did not have any features of toxicity.

Conclusion

We report the largest series of *Abrus* poisoning with a mortality rate of 11.1%. We hope that this study will be of use to physicians who care for these patients.

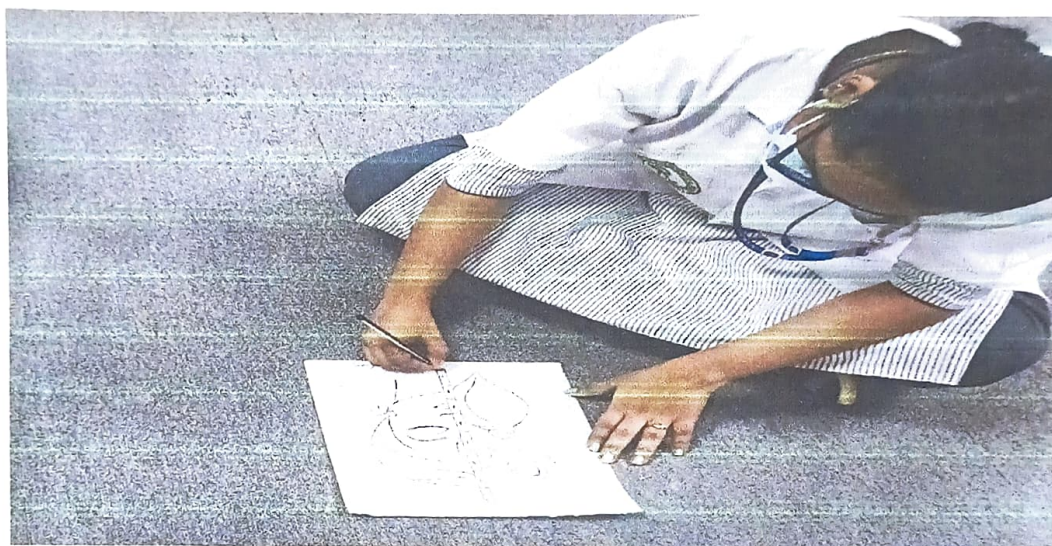


Painting Competition

Kabaddi

Kabaddi for both boys & girls was conducted in college ground with the below rules and regulations.

Each team shall consist of no more than 12 players with only 7 taking to the field at any one time. The duration of the match is two halves of 20 minutes with a half time break of 5 minutes. To win a point when raiding, the raider must take a breath and run into the opposition's half and tag one or more members of the opposing team and then return to their own half of the pitch before inhaling again. To prove that another breath hasn't been taken, the rider must continue to repeatedly yell the word 'Kabaddi'. Failure to do this, even for just a moment means that the rider must return to their own side of the court without points and the opposite team is awarded a point for a successful defense play.

The team being raided is defending, and the players must prevent the raiders from tagging them and returning back over the halfway line. Whilst in defence, a team may score a point by successfully preventing the raider returning to their own half after tagging them. Raiders may only be grabbed by their limbs or torso, not by their hair, clothes or anywhere else, and defenders are not permitted to cross the centre line.

Each team will take turns in raiding and defending. Following halftime, the two teams switch sides of the court and the team who defended first in the first half begin the second half by raiding.

The game continues in this way until the time is up, the team with the most points at the end of the match is declared the winner.

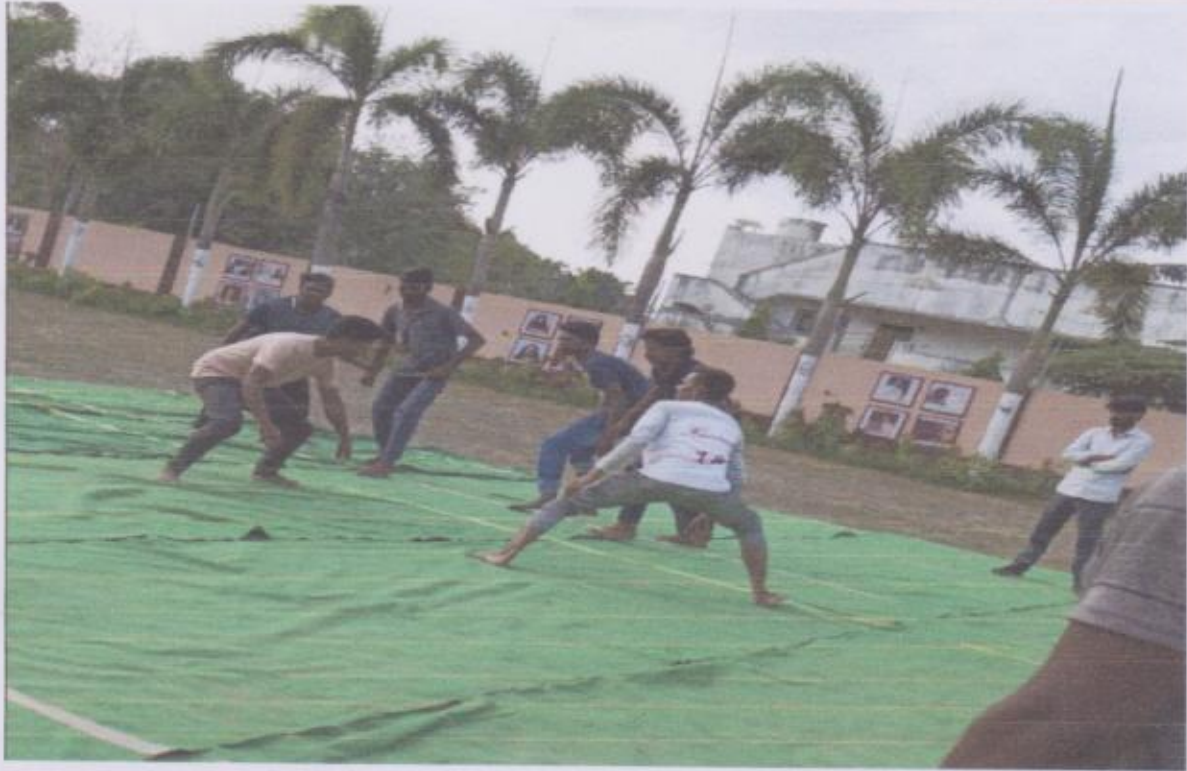

Kho-kho

Match consists of two innings with each inning consisting of chasing and running turns of 9 minutes each. One team sits on their knees in the middle of the court, 8 in a row, with adjacent members facing opposite directions. The runners play in the field, three at a time and the team that takes the shortest time to touch all the opponents in the field, wins. There is a pole at each end of the field and the runner is allowed to go between two sitting players, but the chaser is not allowed to turn back while running or go between the players i.e. the chaser must run in the same direction unless he chooses to touch either end pole and run in the opposite direction. He may cross over to the other side when he is reversing directions by going around the pole.

1. The runner or the chaser is decided by toss.
2. A match consists of two innings of chasing and defending turns, which is each of 9 minutes.
3. The captain of chasing side may end the turn before allotted time.
4. The side that scores more wins a match.
5. When a defender is out, he should enter the sitting box from the lobby.
6. Incomplete match for unavoidable reasons should be played in the same session with the same players and officials. The score of the completed turn should be counted. For incomplete turn, the match will start afresh. The entire match should be replayed from the beginning if the incomplete match is not played in the same session.
7. The chaser can pass-on their turn to any other sitting player by tapping them from the back and saying the term 'kho'.

Kabaddi

Kabaddi for both boys & girls was conducted in college ground with the below rules and regulations.

Each team shall consist of no more than 12 players with only 7 taking to the field at any one time. The duration of the match is two halves of 20 minutes with a half time break of 5 minutes. To win a point when raiding, the raider must take a breath and run into the opposition's half and tag one or more members of the opposing team and then return to their own half of the pitch before inhaling again. To prove that another breath hasn't been taken, the rider must continue to repeatedly yell the word 'Kabaddi'. Failure to do this, even for just a moment means that the rider must return to their own side of the court without points and the opposite team is awarded a point for a successful defense play.

The team being raided is defending, and the players must prevent the raiders from tagging them and returning back over the halfway line. Whilst in defence, a team may score a point by successfully preventing the raider returning to their own half after tagging them. Raiders may only be grabbed by their limbs or torso, not by their hair, clothes or anywhere else, and defenders are not permitted to cross the centre line.

Each team will take turns in raiding and defending. Following halftime, the two teams switch sides of the court and the team who defended first in the first half begin the second half by raiding.

The game continues in this way until the time is up, the team with the most points at the end of the match is declared the winner.

Ruling of the umpire was final Every six balls made an over. Duration of the game was fixed


When a batsman hit the ball, and it straightaway hits the boundary, then the player got four runs. However, if the ball goes beyond the boundary, then the player made six runs.
